Dear Chairman Judd,

This letter is to advise you that the Republican Legislative District Committee for Senate District 24 met on December 3rd at a duly called meeting and determined the method by which the candidate for Senate District 24 would be nominated.

According to the State Party Plan of the Republican Party of Virginia, "The Legislative District Committee shall determine whether candidates for Legislative District public office shall be nominated by Mass Meeting, Party Canvass, Convention or Primary, where permitted to do so under Virginia Law."

It is the determination of the Republican Legislative District Committee for Senate District 24 that the method of nomination for the Senate candidate in 2015 shall be a Convention.

The Committee respectfully requests written confirmation from the State Board of Elections acknowledging that the Legislative District Committee has the right to call a Convention as the means of nominating its candidate in Senate District 24, notwithstanding any contrary preferences of the incumbent in that District.
