Resolution #2015.04 of the Greene County Republican Committee

At its Business Meeting of 16 November 2015

To the Virginia Senate Republican Caucus

WHEREAS, the Republican Creed of Virginia states “that fiscal responsibility and budgetary restraints must be exercised at all levels of government” and “that faith in God as recognized by our Founding Fathers is essential to the moral fiber of the Nation”; and

WHEREAS, at least two Virginia Republican Senators have publicly stated that Senator Tommy Norment’s quest for both positions of Senate Majority Leader and Chairman of the Finance Committee would be an egregious concentration of power in the hands of one individual; and

WHEREAS, Senator Tommy Norment, a married man, personally used the Ashley Madison website and his recent inappropriate involvement with three women, one even being a lobbyist, makes him subject to public ridicule or worse; and

WHEREAS, the Fifth Congressional District Republican Committee, at its meeting of 14 November 2015, overwhelmingly Resolved that Norment step down from his Majority Leadership position or be removed; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Greene County Republican Committee, do hereby call on Senator Tommy Norment to vacate his Senate Majority Leadership Position; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we call on all Virginia Republican State Senators to vote for the removal of Senator Norment should he refuse to vacate the Majority Leadership position.
